EEL 3701 Exam 2 (in Honorlock)

- Mixed-logic (direct-polarity indication)
- Truth Tables/Boolean Algebra/K-maps
 - > CSOP, CPOS, MSOP, MPOS
- Number systems, arithmetic
- SSI elements and circuits
- MSI elements and circuits
 - > MUX, DeMUX, Decoder, Encoder
 - > Tri-state buffer, Open collector, etc.
 - > Half adder, Full adder, Subtractor, Comparator
 - > Static IC characteristics: Fanout, Noise Margin
- LSI elements: PAL, PLA, ROM, RAM
- VLSI elements: PLDs, CPLDs (Altera MAX 3064 & V)
- Memory (latches, FFs, RAM, ROM), Memory Expansion

Exam 2 Approximate Point Distributions


- Combinatorial circuits: 10-20%

EEL 3701 Immediately Prior to the Exam

- Below has been shown to prevent problems that have happened to a few students in the past. It wouldn't hurt and could save some aggravation.
 - > Verify that you have your UF ID, passport, or driver's license (for the Honorlock scan).
 - > Clear your cache in Chrome.
 - Reinstall the Chrome Honorlock Extension.
 - Close then reopen Chrome.
 - > Verify that you have the files that you need (and are allowed) available from your desktop.
 - > Reboot your computer.
- Be sure that there is enough light for your face to be clear during the exam (for Honorlock). If not, find a lamp or a different area.
