



## EEL 3701 Paper Submission at End of Canvas Quiz

- **PRIOR** to the Canvas quiz
  - > Install *CamScanner* or equivalent on your phone
  - > Install a cloud storage app on your phone **and** computer
    - Examples: DropBox, OneDrive, Google Drive, iCloud
- Bring **2** completely blank pieces of paper and pens/pencils.
  - > You must show each of the blank pages to the camera (front and back) at the start of your Canvas quiz.
  - > You will scan and submit these papers with CamScanner or equivalent as specified below.
  - > Clearly write the problem number for each of the problems on your scratch pages.
